Science Students' Association Time Management Award

INTRODUCTION

The Science Students' Association funds were established in 2003 by the Science Students' Association in accordance with the results of its 2002 referendum, while Professor Christian Detellier was Dean of the Faculty of Science. These scholarships are to be made available for Faculty of Science undergraduate students. The fund for the Science Student's Association's Time Management Award was endowed in 2010.

To award a scholarship to undergraduate students at the Faculty of Science who demonstrate a high level of involvement in various activities.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
- 2. be registered full-time in an undergraduate program at the Faculty of Science of the University of Ottawa
- 3. be registered for the upcoming Fall term;
- 4. demonstrate a high level of involvement in various activities; and
- 5. have a minimum CGPA of 7.0.
